It is important that all abstracts are received by the **deadline of Friday, March 27, 2026** and in accordance with the call for abstracts guidelines. The number and quality of abstracts submitted are rising. Space will limit the number of accepted abstracts. See the Call for Abstracts for more information.

Please note that:

- All poster presenters will be expected to register to attend Nurses Expo on April 24, 2026.
- **The main presenter will be able to attend Nurses Expo FREE OF CHARGE.** They will need to register to attend Nurses Expo so we can obtain pertinent information for their registration (home address, breakout session choices, etc).
- Any other presenters will need to register/pay the attendance fee.
- **At least one (1) presenter per poster must be present to discuss their poster and answer questions during all poster sessions.**
- Integrative literature reviews or literature reviews should be submitted under the research category.
- All student literature review posters are eligible and do not have to be published/submitted for publication.
- **All projects need to be completed within the last 24 months.**

CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

DEADLINE TO SUBMIT **Friday, March 27, 2026**

Thirty Third Annual Nurses Expo Poster Session April 24, 2026

The Nurses Expo Posters Committee invites you to submit an abstract for participation in the 32nd annual poster session at Nurses Expo 2026. The purpose of the poster session is to recognize nursing innovations, evidence-based practice projects (EBP), research that reflect the diversity of nursing in clinical practice, administration, and education, and Practice Improvement Projects. Posters will be chosen at the discretion of the Posters Expo Committee for display based on quality of abstract and adherence to specified guidelines. Certificates will be awarded for the best Innovation, EBP/Research, Practice Improvement Project, and a People's Choice. All student submissions will be considered for display.

Nursing innovation abstracts describe ongoing or completed innovations pertaining to a problem that has resulted in the creation or implementation of a new process or product relevant to the field of nursing. Abstracts need to include a description of the problem, purpose and rationale for the project, synthesis of the evidence (if appropriate), description of the actual or proposed change in practice, implementation strategies, and evaluation of the project. There is **no** requirement that these have been published or submitted for publication.

Research and EBP abstracts describe ongoing or completed research that focuses upon timely and relevant nursing problems that is based on current evidence. Abstracts need to include a clear research question, background, sample, methods, synthesis of evidence, results, and implications for practice. Integrative literature reviews and literature reviews are included in this category. There is **no** requirement that these have been published or submitted for publication.

Practice Improvement Projects abstracts include projects such as simulation projects, projects completed or completing at work to improve patient care, lessons learned, successful changes to processes in the nursing field. Abstracts need to include a description of the problem that was addressed, purpose and rationale for the project, synthesis of the evidence (if appropriate), description of the solution or change implemented, implementation strategies, and outcomes and evaluation.

Abstract Submission Guidelines and Specifications

Abstract Requirements:

- All projects need to be completed within the last 24 months
- The title should be no more than 12 words in length and it should not contain abbreviations.
- Center the word Abstract (do not bold, italicize, underline, or use quotation marks).
- The body of the abstract should be written as one paragraph, double-spaced, and justified to the left margin (do not indent).
- Citations are not included in the abstract unless you are citing a specific measurement tool.
- The abstract should be between 150 to 250 words and include a concise summary of all the key points of the project or study.
- The abstract should include the topic, project/research questions, participants, methods, results, data analyses, nursing implications, suggestions for future research, and conclusions but do not create headings for each of these items. A reference list should be provided on a second page.
- The abstract and reference list should follow 7th edition APA format and should be in Microsoft Word.

Deadline for Abstract Submission is: March 27, 2026

Notification of acceptance or Revisions Requested will be on or before **April 1, 2026**
